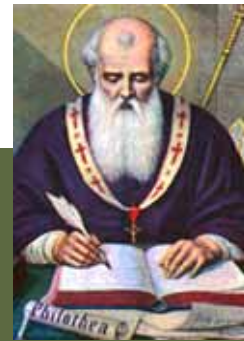

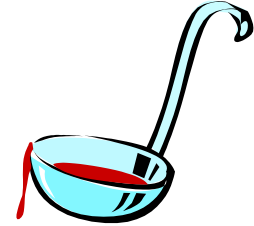
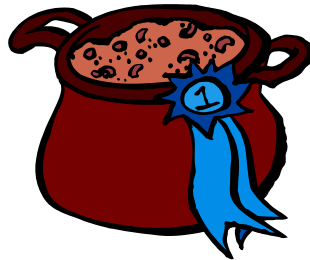

SCHOOL NEWS

The St. Francis de Sales School 8th Grade class took a step back in time as they completed a unit on the American Civil War. The students had a chance to learn about the clothing worn during the 1860s and to learn about the equipment (accouterments) of a soldier. Tyler and Ryan dressed as Union and Confederate soldiers respectively. Tyler portrayed a sergeant in



the signal corps, while Ryan was outfitted as an infantry (foot) soldier. The students were shown replicas of a soldier's accouterments including a haversack, canteen, dishes, mucket, and Springfield rifle.

Lauren, Autumn, and Shelby dressed in the latest fashions of the era (circa 1863). Lauren dressed as a common person, in her camp dress. Autumn and Shelby were representing the upper class, complete with hoop skirts. Autumn dressed in her day attire, while Shelby was ready to go to a ball. The girls all got a chance to find out just how many layers were required to be considered "dressed" for the day – by putting on a chemise, corset, and several petticoats. It was also a way for our students to learn about socially accepted behaviors – including women wearing gloves before holding a man's hand, how a fan could be used to show your interest in a young man, and how a dance card worked. It was a great way to wrap up our unit on one of the most important events in American history. Kudos to Mrs. Vanderwerff, our 8th Grade teacher, for providing all of the Civil War clothes and accouterments!
