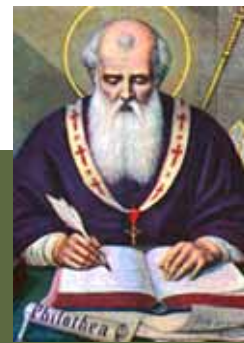

## FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK...

1. I had a wonderful opportunity to meet our new Archbishop, Jerome Listecki, at the welcome on Jan. 7 at St. William Parish in Waukesha. Unfortunately, it was the night of a significant snow and many were unable to come out due to the weather. As priests, we met with Archbishop Listecki prior to the Mass when he introduced himself to us and us to him. While it would be impossible for me share the entire conversation with you, there is one thing I would like to put before you. The Archbishop was asked if he could give an overview of what his hopes would be for this Archdiocese and where his focus would lie. He responded by telling us he wants to work in three very specific areas: **Catholic Identity**-who we are, **Evangelization**-what we are called to do and **Stewardship**-how we do it. The simple directness of his answer spoke volumes to me in terms of his love for the Catholic faith, The Church and the work that we are each called do. He appeared to me to be a man who has a real clarity of vision in terms of his role as shepherd and teacher, a person who can be both decisive and humble and one who strives to be a good listener. I look forward to working with him for the good of the Church of Southeastern Wisconsin and, in particular, for the good of the people at St. Francis de Sales Parish in Lake Geneva.

2. I would like to call your attention to a new bulletin board in the breezeway between the Church and the School. It is an opportunity for people who are searching for employment to post a note listing job skills along with contact information. It is likewise an opportunity for prospective employers to post job openings that are available. Hopefully, we can assist in helping to bring employers and those searching for employment together. Please be sure to check this out.

3. The season of Lent is quickly approaching. I think all of us tend to look for something extra to do during this time of repentance and renewal. To this end, I would like to announce that I will be providing a series of evenings for adult enrichment. Because we currently have Scripture Study as an opportunity, I did not want to enter into competition with groups already in place. Instead, I will be offering a series on the Sacraments. We will begin with an overview of what a sacrament is and follow up with a deeper look into the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation, Eucharist), the Sacraments of Healing (Reconciliation and Anointing of the Sick) and finish with the Sacraments of Commitment (Matrimony and Holy Orders). The sessions will be held on the Mondays of the Lenten Season from 6:30 to 8:00 p.m. I will have more details for you as we get closer to the season.

4. It is with great delight and excitement that I announce to you that we will be creating a new parish pictorial directory. We have three people who stepped forward to spearhead this project: Martha Cucco, Patti Black and Michelle Oberholtzer. There will be dates in February, April and June to have your picture taken and included in the directory. It is an opportunity to help us be able to connect faces and names as well as to tell and retell our parish history with the faces of those who make us who we are. There is no cost to you unless you wish to purchase a package of pictures to distribute to family and friends. All who sign up to have their picture taken will receive a copy of the directory as well as a complimentary 8x10 portrait. With the use of digital photography, you will only need to come to the parish once for posing for the picture and reviewing the results immediately. We are, however, looking for volunteers to assist with some of the detail work of this project. We will need people to staff the signup tables as people make their appointments, as well as help to check people in when they come for their appointment. There is also a need for folks to make some phone calls to remind people of their appointments. While I am most grateful to the three ladies who are spearheading this project for us, they will need your help to make this a reality. Please plan to be a part of this effort by being a part of the directory as well as helping behind the scenes to bring this to fruition.

May God be with you as we continue to celebrate His presence in this far from ordinary time.
