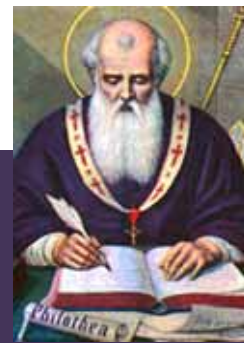

Archbishop Di Noia OP, Secretary of the Congregation for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments recently wrote a wonderful article in the January 2010 Adoremus Bulletin on Eucharistic Adoration and Political Responsibility, Looking at the World through Eyes that Adore the Blessed Sacrament. The Archbishop had some very beautiful thoughts on adoration which we will reflect on in the coming weeks. He writes... *Eucharistic adoration: beholding Christ and being beheld by Him - During Eucharistic adoration, it is not only we who behold Christ, but it is also He who beholds us. When we adore the Blessed Sacrament, we are not just gazing at a beautiful but inert object. The contemplative mode of prayer that we learn during adoration presupposes that Christ returns our gaze...*

LITURGY CORNER

As our Lenten Journey continues, we continue to reflect on our role as assembly and our call to be actively involved in our prayer when we gather for Mass. The hymn board in church is a great tool for us. Everything that is sung by us as an assembly is clearly posted so that all who are gathered can pray with one heart and one voice. Numbers on the Hymn Board refer to the numbers in our hymnal Breaking Bread. Any numbers that begin with “C-“ are located on the insert in the front cover of the hymnal.

In addition, our cantors and choir members encourage all of us to join in our one common song, by welcoming each of us and directing us to take our part in our sung prayer. Nothing is more discouraging than saying “Good Morning” and getting little or no response from the assembly or than announcing a song number and no one picking up a book. Our call is to be actively engaged and participating in our prayer. Our cantors and choir members are not soloists or performers who come to entertain us. Rather, these are members of our own assembly who have come forward to offer their gifts to help us to pray with one, united voice, lifted together in song and prayer. As we journey through this season, may we again hear the call to repent, know our unity in Christ, and bear much fruit.
