Council Meeting Approved Minutes - Summary
August 27, 2009

PRESENT: Fr. Terry, Patrick Frank, Greg Curin, Dave Trautner, Cory Anderson, Phil Hall, Mary Gronke, David Wollman, Bill Rorig, Jack Stotko, Michelle Oberholtzer, Leo Borghgraef, Tom Greenwald, Fr. Angel Anaya.

The previous meeting's minutes were accepted as reported.

OLD BUSINESS: Parish Council Discernment Archdiocesan Orientation is September 12 for anyone who is interested in attending. The rosary card fundraiser proposal was rejected. The Parish Life Committee was assigned the task of looking into a Parish Directory.

NEW BUSINESS: Fr. Angel and the Hispanic community are planning a Kermesse on October 18 to sell Hispanic food. Fr. Angel is also planning formation sessions, and is hoping to start a bible study. An announcement concerning the H1N1 virus pandemic will be made in the bulletin, and plans are being made to have disinfectant available for parishioners and Eucharistic Ministers. Due to lack of time, Fr. Terry said the adult formation sessions may not come to fruition this fall. Rome is moving ahead on the new Sacramentary - Fr. Terry is planning evenings of education for people to learn about the changes.

CATHOLIC CENTRAL HIGH SCHOOL: The situation regarding finances was discussed, and there is no plan to audit the high school - Fr. Terry will be setting up a district meeting with priests and parish directors to discuss the issue further.

BUILDING AND GROUNDS: The new air conditioner has been installed, and a chain-link fence will be installed to protect the equipment. Catholic Mutual Insurance requested we purchase a safe to put the collection monies in after each mass.

SCHOOL ADVISORY: The committee won't meet until September 8th.

FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION: July figures came in as expected - there is a \$95,000 deficit that the council will have to work with the School Advisory Committee on addressing.

HUMAN CONCERNS: There was no meeting. They are scheduled to meet on September 8th.

CHRISTIAN FORMATION: This group is just getting started - ideas are being generated.

PRAYER AND WORSHIP: An idea to have seasonally meetings is being debated.

PARISH LIFE: Blackpoint Mansion is being considered for the 2009 Christmas ornament.
