Council Meeting Approved Minutes - Summary
January 28, 2010

PRESENT: Fr. Terry Huebner, Patrick Frank, Greg Curin, Dave Trautner, Phil Hall, Mary Gronke, David Wollman, Bill Rorig, Jack Stotko, Michelle Oberholtzer.

The previous meeting's minutes were accepted as reported.

OLD BUSINESS: The Constitution and By-Laws were reviewed - the draft will be submitted to the Office of Parish Mission for archdiocese approval. Bulletin and weekly announcements for people interested in joining the council will begin the first Sunday after Easter.

NEW BUSINESS: The staff is looking at options for bringing Catholics back to the Catholic Church in a Christ Renews His Parish Outreach. Stations of the Cross followed by a simple soup supper will occur each Friday through lent, starting at 6:00 pm this year, and Fr. Terry will be leading a series on The Sacramental Life of the Church on Monday evenings during Lent.

BUILDING AND GROUNDS: The plumbing under the gym was re-routed overhead. Electric heat was installed for the entrance to the school. The \$13,000 was paid from gifts to the Capital Fund. A new sacarium, sink and cabinet have been installed in the sacristy.

FINANCE: A rough draft of the budget was made, and will be reviewed in February. There was a motion to pass the budget with a \$50,000 negative balance for next year. The committee forwarded \$5000 for purchase of Script cards without pre-ordering. The Spaghetti Dinner brought in \$2600 towards the parish deficit.

SCHOOL ADVISORY: The enrollment is now 154 students, with a loss of 4 students. Three students owed tuition at the end of the semester. An increase in tuition is being considered. There is a proposal for a 1% merit increase in salary for teachers. The school has begun publishing an Alumnae Newsletter. The Advent Breakfast made \$5500-\$6000. Casino Night is planned for March 20, Catholic School Week is January 31st to February 7th. The students will perform Alice in Wonderland in May at Catholic Central High School.

HUMAN CONCERNS: Human Concerns served pizza at the men's shelter in January. The next dinner will be served March 9th.

CHRISTIAN FORMATION: There was no report. Men of Christ Conference 2010 will be held February 20, 2010.

PRAYER AND WORSHIP: The Council will serve the simple supper after the Stations on Friday 26th.

PARISH LIFE: About 130 people attended the Chili Cook-off - \$300 was made. The Parish Directory is progressing. There will be a Zumba Party on Sunday, April 11th to alleviate the deficit.
