Dear Liturgical Minister,

It's hard to believe that it's already October!! We've been busy here already this fall getting started with the school year, getting back into the regular routine of parish life, and getting more information from the US Bishops about the changes that will be coming to Mass in the next couple of years.

I want to mention this to everyone now, so that we can all be informed and positive about the changes that will be coming. The priests of the diocese, as well as parish staff members had an opportunity this week to hear a presentation by the Most Reverend Bishop Cupich. The primary focus of this presentation was the changes that will be upcoming, but more so WHY these changes are coming, and how we, as those who serve the people of God, need to see this as an opportunity to learn more, to dig deeper, to really embrace who we are and what we believe as a Catholic people. That is what we need to keep in mind through all of this!



More information will be coming forward in the next couple of months as publishers begin preparing information to help us to journey through these changes together. The USCCB has set up a website to help us to see and explain these changes:

I do want to assure everyone that **the Mass itself is not changing**. We are not going back to the "old Mass" or going back to having Mass in Latin. The changes we will be seeing are simply a re-translation of the texts we already use at Mass. Our current texts were first published in Latin in 1969, translated into English in 1970, with a final version in 1974. In 1975 a new Latin text was published, with minor revisions: removing sub-deacon parts, and adding things like Masses for Children and Reconciliation. The translation of the 1975 Latin text into English was published in 1985. In 2002, the third Latin edition was published, adding to the liturgical calendar to include the many saints that have been canonized, adding new Eucharistic Prayers, and new seasonal prayers. This is the revision which is currently being translated into English, which will include some changes for our assemblies. We are expecting to see these changes sometime in 2012 or 2013, once Rome has approved the materials presented by the US Bishops.

This can be a very exciting time for us to begin to renew ourselves and our spirituality! I hope that each of you will join me in being positive about these changes, and hopefully we can all come to know more about our faith, our Church, and come closer to God through our study and our prayer together!

- If Fr. Angel is saying Mass, after you have brought the Chalice and Gifts to the Altar, you will need to bring him the Lavabo so that he can wash his hands. (Towel over your arm, glass bowl in one hand, and cruet of water in the other. Pour the water slowly over his hands.)
