The Church earnestly desires that all the faithful be led to that full, conscious, and active participation in liturgical celebrations called for by the very nature of the liturgy. Such participation by the Christian people as “a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God’s own people” is their right and duty by reason of their baptism.

IN THE REFORM AND PROMOTION OF THE LITURGY, THIS FULL AND ACTIVE PARTICIPATION BY ALL THE PEOPLE IS THE AIM TO BE CONSIDERED BEFORE ALL ELSE.

ALL cantors will continue to meet once a month (**typically the 4th Tuesday of the month from 6:30 – 8:00 p.m.**) to go over any new music and all of the psalmody for the upcoming month. If you are a cantor and cannot attend rehearsal, please try to find a convenient time to make up that rehearsal with me.

Advent Notes:

Advent has a two-fold character: as a season to prepare for Christmas when Christ's first coming to us is remembered; as a season when that remembrance directs our mind and heart to await Christ's second coming at the end of time. Advent thus is a period of devout and joyful expectation (General Norms for the Liturgical Year and Calendar, 39).

The use of the organ and other musical instruments and the decorating of the altar with flowers should be done in a moderate manner, as is consonant with the character of the season, without anticipating the full joy of Christmas (Caeremoniale Episcoporum, 236).

In light of these directives, and in order to make a distinction between the seasons of Advent and Christmas, I am asking that all musicians observe the following practices during Advent. The liturgies for Advent should reflect a quality of simplicity and anticipation, focusing on the general principles of assembly song and prayer.

- On the Sundays of Advent, the "Glory to God" will NOT be sung. The "Glory to God" is sung on the feasts of the Immaculate Conception and Our Lady of Guadalupe.
- The response to the General Intercessions will be the Trilingual Intercessions. First, a **cantor** will intone the response from the Cantor Stand, then the assembly will sing it, then the **cantor** will begin the intercessions. The response is sung once after each of the intercessions.
- The Lord's Prayer will be recited and not sung, at all Advent Masses.
- The time of meditation following Communion will be more reflective in nature. You may play an instrumental, sing a reflective choral piece, or observe silence. The time of reflection begins when everyone has received Communion.

Advent Wreath:

We will bless the Advent Wreath and Candles only during the celebrations of the First Sunday of Advent. Before the conclusion of this blessing, we will sing "Come, Lord Jesus" SS174. The cantor will intone the refrain, and we will sing the refrain 2 more times, with the assembly.

Christmas Notes:

The liturgies at Christmas as set out in the sacramentary and lectionary seek to express and shape the spirituality not of one person or of a single cultural community, but of the entire ecclesial bodies of those baptized into the paschal mystery of Jesus Christ. They set before us the powerful challenge of the Christmas child who is not our personal or communal past, but the dawning future we share with all humanity. (Taken from "What Child is This?" Jennifer Glenn, Notre Dame Center for Liturgy)

Next to the yearly celebration of the paschal mystery, the Church holds most sacred the memorial of Christ's birth and early manifestations. This is the purpose of the Christmas season. (General Norms, 32)

- **Starting with Christmas Eve Mass, we sing the "Glory to God" every Sunday during the season of Christmas. This season is second only to that of Easter. In a sense, this is a time to "pull out all the stops." Our celebrations should be solemn and festive, celebrating with great joy the life of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ! This is indeed a time of celebration.**
- **The response to the General Intercessions will be "O Lord, Hear Our Prayer" (octavo). First, a cantor will intone the response, then the assembly will sing it, then the Lector will read the intercessions. The response is sung once after each of the intercessions.**
