“O God, Beyond All Praising, We Worship You Today!  
We Honor and Adore You, Our Great and Mighty Lord!”

As we journey into a new Liturgical Year, we recall what it means to be a servant. We are called not to fulfill our own desires, but to seek the will of the Church: to encourage and promote the prayer and participation of every person gathered. We begin this new season of grace, by first examining our own desires, and realizing that our duty is so much more than providing beautiful music for an assembly to listen to. Our call is to step outside of ourselves, to become transparent, and to support the voice of each person gathered, without getting in the way! The primary voice we should hear in our churches is that of the assembly gathered to pray. Let us pray for the grace to always be gracious, supportive, and encouraging as we help those gathered to find their voice! May we always be thankful for the many gifts and talents that the Lord has bestowed upon us!

We are all first and foremost members of the assembly who come to pray. It is our job as liturgical musicians to encourage and promote the sung prayer of the community. **It is never our job to “perform” or to “take the place of” the song of the whole community. It is not about OUR song or about what moves us as musicians... our job is to enable every person in the pew to find their voice. The music we sing must be the music of the whole assembly, and this music must serve the rites we celebrate!** The assembly gathers each weekend around the Altar (Eucharist), the Ambo (Word/Scripture), and the Priest (Presider). The assembly does not gather around the musicians. We must be transparent and humble in all that we do, so that people are more able to focus on the liturgy and prayer which we celebrate, and not on us, nor the music that is sung.

***The Church earnestly desires that all the faithful be led to that full, conscious, and active participation in liturgical celebrations called for by the very nature of the liturgy. Such participation by the Christian people as “a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God’s own people” is their right and duty by reason of their baptism.***

***IN THE REFORM AND PROMOTION OF THE LITURGY, THIS FULL AND ACTIVE PARTICIPATION BY ALL THE PEOPLE IS THE AIM TO BE CONSIDERED BEFORE ALL ELSE.***

**Cantor rehearsal will be once a month (typically the 2<sup>nd</sup> Thursday of the month at 7:00 p.m. in the Music Room). In addition to going over new music and all of the psalmody for the upcoming month, we will be talking about the role of cantor and how we can more effectively engage and encourage the song of our assembly. All cantors are expected to attend.**

## **Advent Notes:**

*Advent has a two-fold character: as a season to prepare for Christmas when Christ's first coming to us is remembered; as a season when that remembrance directs our mind and heart to await Christ's second coming at the end of time. Advent thus is a period of devout and joyful expectation (General Norms for the Liturgical Year and Calendar, 39).*

*The use of the organ and other musical instruments and the decorating of the altar with flowers should be done in a moderate manner, as is consonant with the character of the season, without anticipating the full joy of Christmas (Caeremoniale Episcoporum, 236).*

**In light of these directives, and in order to make a distinction between the seasons of Advent and Christmas, I am asking that all musicians observe the following practices during Advent. The liturgies for Advent should reflect a quality of simplicity and anticipation, focusing on the general principles of assembly song and prayer.**

- On the Sundays of Advent, the "Glory to God" will NOT be sung. The "Glory to God" is sung on the feasts of the Immaculate Conception and Our Lady of Guadalupe.
- The Lord's Prayer will be recited or chanted at all Advent Masses.
- The music during the Communion Procession should be finished by the time the priest sits down, following Communion.

## **Advent Wreath:**

**We will bless the Advent Wreath and Candles only during the celebrations of the First Sunday of Advent.** During the blessing, the cantor/choir will hum the verses to "O Come, O Come Emmanuel." At the conclusion of the blessing, ALL sing the Refrain "Rejoice, Rejoice." All done a capella.

## **Christmas Notes:**

*The liturgies at Christmas as set out in the Sacramentary and lectionary seek to express and shape the spirituality not of one person or of a single cultural community, but of the entire ecclesial bodies of those baptized into the paschal mystery of Jesus Christ. They set before us the powerful challenge of the Christmas child who is not our personal or communal past, but the dawning future we share with all humanity. (Taken from "What Child is This?" Jennifer Glenn, Notre Dame Center for Liturgy)*

*Next to the yearly celebration of the paschal mystery, the Church holds most sacred the memorial of Christ's birth and early manifestations. This is the purpose of the Christmas season. (General Norms, 32)*

- **Starting with Christmas Eve Mass, we sing the "Glory to God" every Sunday during the season of Christmas.**
- **This season is second only to that of Easter. In a sense, this is a time to "pull out all the stops." Our celebrations should be solemn and festive, celebrating with great joy the life of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ! This is indeed a time of celebration.**
- **The response to the General Intercessions will be spoken.**
